Global Wind Power France holds a portfolio of more than 1000-megawatt (MW) of onshore wind projects, including 250 MW scheduled to come on stream by 2025.

This acquisition strengthens Total Quadran's footprint adding to its existing portfolio of nearly 1000 MW of installed and operated capacity, including over 500 MW of onshore wind.
